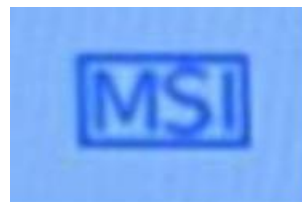
Great Lakes Regional Update

- GLMAB was held virtually last November
- The first Great Lakes e-Navigation subcommittee will be held Spring 2022;
- Co-Chairs have been identified
- Term of Reference drafted
- e-Navigation Coordinator will be assigned



Great Lakes Regional Update

- The industry and government e-Navigation roadmap was presented, this following the identification of the five e-Navigation priorities;
- The concepts of digitalization/standardization of the services were presented (S-123-Radio Service and S-124-NAVWARN);
- The modernization of information exchange was presented. CCG will develop a web platform and API for voyage management and exchange. This would make integration with Maritime Single Window possible;
- Canada is leading some efforts with other countries to raise awareness on the low capacity for shipborne equipment to display AIS ASM messages (Met/hydro, air gap, ice routes, area notices).
